

Perry names San Antonio woman to state environmental advisory group

A San Antonio woman has been appointed to the state's Environmental Flows Advisory Group.

The panel will make policy recommendations to the 81st Texas Legislature related to environmental flow standards, while balancing the needs of Texas' water resources with a growing population.

Gov. Rick Perry chose Karen Hixon, already a member of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Commission, to serve on the advisory group. Hixon also serves on the board of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Foundation and the Peregrine Fund in Boise, Idaho.

She is also on the advisory board for the Trust for Public Land and the Mitchell Lake Audubon Center and is chairwoman of the San Antonio Museum of Art board of trustees.
